## ~ Acceptable Worship ~


When Jesus met the Samaritan woman at Jacob's Well their conversation soon turned to the matter of worship. The woman insisted that Mount Gerizim was the only proper place to worship God, while acknowledging that the Jews insisted that Jerusalem was the proper place for worship. To this Jesus responded, "Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father." Jesus added, "The hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him." Then Jesus explained, "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth" (Jn. 4: 21-24).

Acceptable worship of God is worship in spirit and truth. It is spiritual worship done in and with the right attitude. Acceptable worship is also according to the truth of God's word (Jn. 17:17; 8:32).

Acceptable worship includes singing (Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16), observing the Lord's Supper (Acts 20:7; 1 Cor. 11: 17-34), praying (1 Cor. 4:15-16; 1 Th. 5:17), giving (1 Cor. 16:2), and study of God's word (Col. 4:16; Acts 20:7).

Regular worship of God is vital to successfully living the Christian life (Mt. 4:10). Regular attendance at the worship services of the Lord's church is commanded-and expected- by God (Heb. 10:25). How could God's children not want to meet with God's family (1 Tim. 3:15) to worship our Father in Heaven?
