“He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?” (Micah 6:8 ESV). What does God want for His children?

One, God wants us to grow spiritually (2 Peter 3:18; Ephesians 4:13). Two, He wants us to glorify Him (1 Corinthians 10:31; Colossians 3:17). Three, He wants us to live eternally with Him in heaven (John 14:1-3).

What should we as Christians want? First, we should want to live faithful Christian lives. Life is a gift from God (James 1:17; James 4: 13-15). We should live our lives for Jesus Christ.

Look at the example of the Apostle Paul. He wanted Christ to be magnified in his body, whether by life or by death. He wrote, “For me to live is Christ, and to die is gain” (Philippians 1:20-21). He told the brethren, “I am ready not only to be bound, but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus” (Acts 21:13).

Second, we should want to receive eternal life, which is a gift that comes by the grace of God through faith that results in obedience (Romans 6:23; Ephesians 2:8; Matthew 7:21; John 14:15).

Life and eternal life are gifts from God. Our lives should be lived for Jesus Christ (Matthew 5:13-16). Eternal life will be ours from God through Christ by obedience to His gospel (2 Timothy 1:10; Romans 1:16-17).
