~ Jesus Is The Christ ~

The sermon this morning will focus on "The Healing of the Lame Man" (Jn. 5: 1-16), while the evening sermon will look at "The Claims of Christ" (Jn. 5: 17-24). Both of these are a part of our continuing series from the Gospel of John. I hope you are enjoying these sermons as much as I am enjoying preparing and preaching them.

Why is this series so important? First, because it is Bible-based, as all gospel sermons must be. Second, because the sermons are focused on the life of Christ, the most important Person in the history of the world. Third, because of John's special focus and emphasis. John's gospel is built around seven signs from Jesus. These are turning water to wine (Jn. 2), the healing of the nobleman's son (Jn. 4), the healing of the lame man (Jn. 5), the feeding of the five thousand (Jn. 6), Jesus walking on water (Jn. 6), the healing of the blind man (Jn. 9), and the raising of Lazarus (Jn. 11).

In addition to those miracles, there is the greatest miracle of all, the bodily resurrection of Jesus from the dead (Jn. 20-21). John reminds us that there were many other miracles performed by Jesus (Jn. 21:25), and that their purpose was to show us that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, so that we might have life in His name (Jn. 20: 30-31).

Why are we studying the Gospel of John? To further confirm our faith that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God.
