REPENTANCE

What is repentance? The basic word means to change or turn. A more complete definition is that repentance is a change of heart, mind, will and attitude in reference to sin that leads to and results in a change or reformation of life. Repentance is very important.

Both Jesus and John the Baptist preached the necessity of repentance (Mt. 3:2; Mt. 4:17). Jesus stressed the importance of repentance when He said, "I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish" (Lk. 13:3, 5). He commanded "that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations" (Lk. 24:47). The twelve preached "that people should repent" (Mk. 6:12). Peter preached repentance and baptism for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38; Acts 3:19; Acts 8:22). Later he wrote that the Lord commanded "That all should come to repentance" (2 Pt. 3:9).

Paul emphasized the necessity of repentance. He told the Athenians that God "now commands all men everywhere to repent" (Acts 17:30). He said that God declared that men "should repent, turn to God, and do works befitting repentance" (Acts 26:20).

Jesus commanded five of the seven churches of Asia Minor to repent (Rev. 2:5; 2:16; 2:21-22; 3:3; 3:19). Jesus came to call sinners to repentance (Mt. 9:13). The goodness of God leads us to repentance (Rom. 2:4). Finally, "Godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death" (2 Cor. 7:10). Repentance is necessary to salvation.
