Jesus made a lot of incredible statements during His time on earth. These often caused those who heard Him to reject His message. He actually taught that after His death He would live again. For example after He had chased money changers out of the temple the Jews asked Him what authority He had to do what He did. John wrote “Jesus answered and said to them, ‘Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.’ Then the Jews said, ‘It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?’ But He was speaking of the temple of His body” (John 2:19-21). But the most incredible thing about this claim was that He actually followed through. John 2:22 says “Therefore, when He had risen from the dead, His disciples remembered that He had said this to them; and they believed the Scripture and the word which Jesus had said.” As we study our Bibles, let us look to accounts like this one, and have our faith strengthened also.
