"He Has Risen!"

In last Sunday morning's sermon we discussed the crucifixion of Christ. In today's sermon we will study the resurrection of Christ. Our study will be based largely on Luke 24. We will divide the lesson into two major parts. First we will discuss the role of the witnesses and then the place of the word in the resurrection story. The witnesses include the women, the angels, Peter, the two on the road to Emmaus, the disciples, Jesus Himself, and the promise of the Holy Spirit. This point will be followed by a second point, the witness of the word to the resurrected Jesus. The first point covers Luke 24: 1-43, while the second point includes Luke 24: 44-49.

Paul said that the death, burial and resurrection of Christ were things "of first importance" and that they were "according to the Scriptures" (1 Cor. 15: 3-4). These three events were followed by Jesus' post-resurrection appearances, which included appearances to Cephas, the twelve, more than five hundred brethren at once, James, all the apostles, and then to Paul himself. These eyewitnesses saw the resurrected Jesus.

At the heart of the gospel is the resurrection of Christ. By His bodily resurrection Jesus was "declared the Son of God with power" (Rom. 1: 4). One who denies the bodily resurrection of Jesus, or refuses to believe it, rejects the truth of the gospel. Without the resurrection of our Lord, there would be no gospel and no true Christianity.
