One New Man

You don't have to read far into the New Testament before you realize that Jews and Gentiles did not care much for each other. The contempt between the two was not God's desire for them. Paul said, **"For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity"** (Ephesians 2:14-17). This passage simply teaches that through Christ all people can find reconciliation to God and that those who are reconciled to God are made one. No longer should it be Jew vs. Gentile but one group of God's people in harmony with each other and with God. Our world always has, and always will, let things like race, gender, income, and various other things separate them. It should never be that those in the body of Christ let these things divide them. We should live in unity with all who have been reconciled through the cross.
