"A Living Hope"

Simon Peter was a walking contradiction. He confessed Jesus as the Christ (Mt. 16: 16), but denied Him three times. He preached the first gospel sermon (Acts 2), wrote two New Testament letters, and was a mentor to John Mark. Tradition says that he was asked to be crucified upside down because he did not believe he was worthy to be crucified like our Lord was.

Peter wrote his first letter to encourage Christians to live for Christ despite opposition and persecution. He wrote to remind us of our "living hope" (1 Pt. 1:3). What is hope? It has been defined as an eager desire coupled with an earnest expectation. We are not talking about political or economic hope, but the spiritual hope that is ours in Jesus.

Before we became Christians we lived without hope (Eph. 2:1-3). We had "no hope" and were "without God in the world" (Eph. 2:12). "But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ" (Eph. 2:13).

Today the faith of Christians is under attack from all sides. What can we do? We must keep our eyes fixed on Jesus (Heb. 12:2). He is our hope. What does this hope give us? It gives us "an inheritance which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you" (1 Pt. 1:4). On what is this hope based? "The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead" (1 Pt. 1:3). What a marvelous hope we have in Christ!
