~ THE ARREST OF JESUS ~

Over the next four Sundays we will look at the last days in the earthly life of Jesus prior to His resurrection, as well as His resurrection and ascension. Today we begin this series of lessons by studying His arrest. These sermons will be based on the Gospel of John, which makes them part of our series of sermons on John. Today's lesson comes from John 18.

One way to look at these events is to view them as a drama. This is meant in no way to lessen the importance of the events. In fact, it emphasizes their importance. Today's sermon begins with the scene being set (Jn. 18:1). Then the characters are introduced. Of course the most important character is Jesus, "the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world" (Jn. 1:29).

The next person introduced into the narrative is Judas, who had already agreed to betray the Lord for thirty pieces of silver. He was accompanied by Roman soldiers and officers from the temple, who arrested Jesus. Then we read of the confrontation between Simon Peter and Malchus, the high priest's servant.

After Jesus was arrested He was taken first to Annas, the father-in-law of Caiaphas, who was the high priest. Then Caiaphas sent Jesus to Pontius Pilate, the Roman governor, who released Barabbas and ordered Jesus to be crucified. That is the cast of characters. All of them play a part in the plan of God to save the world.
