Every morning I wake up and start a routine of getting ready for the day. Truth be told I don't usually give much thought to many of the things I do. For example I walk into the kitchen to pour a cup of coffee. But I rarely sit back and think "wow...what a blessing to be able to walk". Imagine, for a moment, not being able to walk. It would certainly change the way we do things. John five tells us about a time when Jesus healed a man who had not walked in 38 years; but, before Jesus healed the man He asked a really interesting question. Many don't see themselves as needing Jesus and some just don't want Him. Make no mistake about it, Jesus can heal you, but you must desire to be made well.
