Today is first and foremost the day on which we are privileged to worship the living God in spirit and truth (Acts 20: 7; 1 Th. 1: 10; Jn. 4: 24). But today is also a very special day on which we honor our mothers. Our mothers deserve this and so much more. Moms, we thank and praise you for all that you do and all that you are. For example, we are to bear "with one another in love" (Eph. 4: 2). The body of Christ is to be edified (Eph. 4: 12). We are to "grow up in all things into Him who is Head—Christ" (Eph. 4: 15). We are to "comfort each other and edify one another" (1 Th. 5: 11). To edify is to build up. We are to build each other up in the faith. Other verses make this same point, but these are sufficient. We are to encourage each other in the faith.
