In the book of Daniel we are introduced to three men: Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego. You are probably aware that these men were commanded by their king to worship a false god. The consequence, if they refused, was that they would be thrown into a fiery furnace. I would like you to read what they told the king when this order was made known to them. **“Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego answered and said to the king, ‘O Nebuchadnezzar, we have no need to answer you in this matter. If that is the case, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us from your hand, O king. But if not, let it be known to you, O king, that we do not serve your gods, nor will we worship the gold image which you have set up’”** (Daniel 3:16-18). If you're like me you have known this story from the time you were young but please don't let it be commonplace to you. Try to put yourself in these men's shoes (or sandals). They had faith that God was able to deliver them but they were not sure if He would. Nevertheless, that did not change their actions. They were willing to burn to death in a fiery furnace in order to remain true to God. That is devotion. Let us learn to devote ourselves to God in that way.
