## What Are We Sowing?

The word “sow” is used 80 times in the Bible. Sometimes it is used literally but it is also often used symbolically. Paul said **“Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life”**

(Galatians 6:7-9). Paul, in this passage, taught an important lesson about life. In the same way that a farmer who sows corn will only reap corn (and no other crop), likewise, those who sow to the flesh (fleshly indulgence) will only reap corruption. However, those who sow to the Spirit will reap everlasting life. We should never think that we can live for the flesh yet reap spiritual rewards. Likewise, let us not think that a spiritual life has no rewards. So, as we consider this teaching, let us all ask ourselves “what are we sowing?”
