Raja Rao Vijayawada, South India

Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. The Lord has done great things through Churches of Christ India Missions. Thank you, Southern Hills, for contributing to my mission trips to various places. I extend my heartfelt gratitude to the many Christians and Churches of Christ for their support during this challenging time.

God is our focus, and we trust Him to be our constant guide and provider. I am always thankful to God for allowing us to serve Him better each month with ongoing flood relief assistance. We distributed groceries, clothes, and medicines to 22 families this month in addition to our past month's distribution work.

In the School of Preaching, February was incredibly enriching as we dedicated our studies to the Book of Revelation. The students extensively explored its powerful message—learning about Christ's ultimate victory, the perseverance of the saints, and the promise of eternal life.

In our Bible Project, our gatherings recently were attended by Saints, Hindus, and Muslims, we often offer Bibles on the day as a gesture of encouragement, inviting participants to explore the Gospel. Also, every newly baptized believer receives a Bible to strengthen their faith and deepen their understanding of God's truth. By God's grace, I have distributed 216 Bibles this month.

February has been an incredible month, filled with opportunities to share the Gospel and witness the unwavering faith of God's people. I was blessed to conduct several Gospel campaigns, including a night Gospel meeting with over 70 attendees eager to hear the Word of God. Seeing these believers' devotion firsthand was one of this month's most wonderful moments, there were no fancy buildings, no comfortable pews—just a group of faithful souls gathered on an asphalt road, worshiping under the open night sky.
