Going from Me to We

“Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.” (Hebrews 10:19-25)

According to Jesus, judgment includes an assessment of how considerate you were during your days on earth (Matthew 25.31-36). There are two preconditions to becoming a considerate person. You must draw near and hold fast. Those who draw near to Jesus grow in appreciation for His love. Those who hold fast to Jesus imitate His life. The goal is not only to be with Christ but to be like Christ.

The result of this nearness and resoluteness is better relationships. Wonderful things happen when you go from a “me” mindset to an “us” mindset. He loved “me” and died for “me.” Therefore, let “us” consider how to stir up one another to love and good works. A “me” mindset must become an “us” mindset over time, or it will end in frustration and alienation. An “us” mindset leads to growing friendship and fellowship.
