THE BLOOD OF CHRIST (II)

Last week we studied the biblical concept of the blood of Christ. We saw that understanding types and antitypes is imperative to understanding the Bible.

Leviticus 16 describes the procedure to be followed on the Day of Atonement, perhaps the most important day of the Jewish year. That day, with its emphasis on blood atonement for sins, is the type of which the blood shed by Jesus on the cross is the antitype (Heb. 9:11-- 10:4). The blood of Christ, offered once for all time, does what the blood of bulls and goats could not do. It takes away our sins (Heb. 9:12; Rom. 6:1-4; Acts 22:16).

Today we continue to study the biblical doctrine of the blood of Christ by focusing on Ephesians 1:7. We will discuss four thoughts. (1) Our salvation is in Him (Jn. 14:6; Acts 4:12). (2) We are redeemed by the blood of Christ. This redemption is defined as "the forgiveness of sins." (3) This redemption comes through the blood of Christ. (4) This redemption comes by the grace of God.

Bible study is important because it shows us the divine wisdom and power of God. It also emphasizes His love, grace and mercy. Please study the Bible with us at every opportunity. As one mother wrote on the flyleaf of her son's Bible, "This little book will keep you from sin. Sin will keep you from this little book."
