Over the last few weeks we have studied the events that took place during the last week in the earthly life of Jesus. These include His betrayal, arrest, trials, crucifixion and resurrection. Today we look at the ascension of our Lord back to the right hand of God in heaven. It is a central doctrine of the Bible.

The word ascend means "to go upward." Thus the ascension is "the bodily ascending of the resurrected Jesus Christ from earth to heaven." It is described in detail in the Bible (Mk. 16:19; Lk. 24:50-53; Acts 1:9-11).

This event was also prophesied (Ps. 68:18; Eph. 4:8-10; Dan. 7:13-14). It was predicted by Jesus (Jn. 14:1-3, 12, 28). The apostles and other inspired men preached and wrote about the ascension. These include Peter (Acts 2:33-35; Acts 5:31; 1 Pt. 3:22), Stephen (Acts 7:55-56), Paul (Eph. 1:20; 1 Tim. 3:16; Col. 3:1), and the author of Hebrews (1:3; 2:9; 4:14; 7:26; 8:1; 9:24; 10:12; and 12:2).

Mark wrote, "So then, when the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God" (Mk. 16:19). Luke said, "He parted from them and was carried up into heaven" (Lk. 24:51).

What is Jesus doing in heaven at the right hand of God? He serves as our Savior (Jn. 3:16-17; Jn. 4:42). He is our mediator (1 Tim. 2:5). He is our Advocate (1 Jn.2:1). And He "intercedes for us" (Rom. 8:34; Heb. 7:25).

The ascension of Christ was described, prophesied, predicted and preached. It truly is a central doctrine of the word of God.
