The Word Of God

As apologist Norman Geisler wrote, "The Bible claims to be and proves to be the word of God." That is confirmed by such passages as 2 Timothy 3: 16-17 and 1 Corinthians 2: 13-16. Paul referred to the Old Testament as "the oracles of God" (Rom. 3:2). The author of Hebrews wrote, "For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of the soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Heb. 4:12).

The strongest argument for the inspiration and authority of the Bible comes from Jesus Himself. As Geisler stated, "The authority of Jesus confirms the authority of the Bible. If He is the Son of God, then the Bible is the word of God." Therefore, we can reject the authority of the Bible only if we reject the authority of Christ.

The argument can be stated like this. (1) Jesus is the Son of God. (2) Whatever Jesus affirmed to be true is true. (3) Jesus affirmed that the Bible is the word of God. (4) Therefore, it is true that the Bible is the word of God and whatever is opposed to biblical teaching is false.

When Satan tempted Jesus three times, each time our Lord answered him with Scripture. And each time Jesus prefaced His answer with, "It is written" (Mt. 4: 4, 7, 10). This indicates the respect the Lord had for the word of God. It is the word of God.
