NO GREATER LOVE

Last week a former student at a North Carolina university walked into a classroom and began firing a pistol at students. Two students were killed and four were wounded. The carnage would have been greater had not 21 year old student Riley Howell rushed forward and tackled the gunman. For his effort to save the lives of others, Howell gave his life. He is being hailed as a hero, and rightly so.

When I first heard the news I immediately thought of the words of Jesus. "Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends" (Jn. 15:13). When someone gives his or her life for another person we honor the person and the act. How much then should we honor Jesus for giving His life on the cross for us?

John 15:13 first refers to the love His disciples are to have for each other. But beyond that it refers to His love for us. Someone wrote, "The eternal divine love reached its complete and unsurpassed expression in the death of Christ." Leon Morris calls it "the greatest love of all." He adds, "In this context this must refer primarily to the love of Jesus as shown in the cross."

The point is that God loves us so much that He gave His Son to die for us. And the Son gave up His life for us so that we might be freed from sin, live in fellowship with the Father and the Son, and have the hope of eternal life in heaven. ~ Dan Cottrell
