THREE KEY QUESTIONS

Questions are an important part of the Bible. Our answers tell us a lot about ourselves and our relationship with God. The first question in the Bible was asked by Satan (Gen. 3:1). The second question was asked by God. Adam and Eve, after they had sinned, "heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden." They "hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God". So God asked Adam, "Where are you?" (Gen. 3: 8-9). Where are you in your relationship with God?

The second key question was asked by Jesus (Mt. 16:26). "For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?" When someone dies, his body and soul are separated. At the resurrection "all who are in the graves will hear His voice and come forth--those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation" (Jn. 5: 28-29). "For what profit is it to a man if he loses his own soul?"

The third question comes from Acts 16:30. The Philippian jailer asked Paul and Silas, "What must I do to be saved?" The jailer knew that Paul and Silas could answer his question, and they did (vs. 31-34). What must we do to be saved? Hear, believe, repent, confess, be baptized and live a Christian life. Three key questions with answers with eternal consequences.
