* A Great Church (3) *

The sermon this morning is the third in a series on "A Great Church," based on 1 Thessalonians. In the first sermon we studied three characteristics that make a church great: Its (1) work of faith, (2) labor of love and (3) steadfastness of hope (1 Th. 1: 3). Last Sunday we saw three more characteristics of a great church. (1) It is made up of the chosen or elect, those who have obeyed the gospel of Christ (1 Th. 1:4-5). (2) It is an example of what a church should be (1 Th. 1:6-7). (3) It is evangelistic (1 Th. 1:8).

Today we will examine the basic reason as to why the church at Thessalonica was a great church (1 Th. 1:9-10). Verses 9 and 10 are dominated by a preposition that appears three times in the passage. The preposition is "to". Paul uses it to introduce the three main points of our lesson. (1) They had turned to God from idols. (2) This was to serve the living and true God. (3) It was to wait for His Son from heaven. The keys are to God, to serve and to wait.

Several questions will be asked. What is an idol? Who is the true and living God? Who is His Son? How do we know that? From where will the Son come? What will the Son do? We must know and obey God and His Son.
