Their power is the power of Christ (Matt. 28: 18). Because Christians are people with purpose, potential and power, they are people of value. Our value is realized as we fulfill God's purpose, realize our potential for God, and accomplish all things by His power. Our value is realized as, and to the extent that, Christ lives in us (Col. 1: 27).

Christians are saved to serve (Eph. 1: 6, 11, 12, 22-23). As Christians and as the church, God's power is working through us to help us realize our potential and accomplish His purpose (Rom. 8:28). Christians live lives that affirm our faith in God (Gen. 1: 1; Acts 17: 28), His Son (Matt. 3: 17; 16: 16; 17: 5; Rom. 1: 4), and His word (Ps. 119: 105; 2 Tim. 3: 16-17). Christians testify to these great truths by both precept and example.

Christian citizens are a nation's best citizens. Christians confirm and support Christian values. They have Christian homes, where God is glorified, prayers are prayed, the Bible is read, and God's word is obeyed. Christians judge, evaluate and value all things in the light of God's word and in view of judgment and eternity. Christians function as salt (Matt. 5: 13), light (Matt. 5: 14-16), and leaven (Matt. 13: 33). Finally, Christians look forward with hope and faith to the life with God that is eternal (2 Tim. 4: 7-8). All of these things are a great part of living the Christian life.
