~ Fishers of Men ~

When I was a boy my dad and I made an annual fishing trip to Harmon's Creek on Kentucky Lake with Dad's boss, Hugh Brooks (who later became a professional fisherman). The trip, whether we caught fish or not, was always a highlight of my year. I have not been to Harmon's Creek in many years. In fact, I do not fish at all. But I really did enjoy those trips.

In Mark 1 Jesus called two fishermen, Simon and Andrew, to "Follow Me." The verb "to follow" appears approximately eighty times in the gospel accounts. In each case it describes the relationship that Christians have with Jesus. We are to follow Him faithfully because He is the Son of God, the Lord and the Savior of the world. In fact, the name Christian describes (or should) people who faithfully follow Christ (Acts 11: 26).

Jesus promised those two fishermen, "I will make you become fishers of men." Those men who were fishermen would become fishers of men. If we are faithful followers of Jesus we are to be fishers of men. Notice that Jesus promises that we will "become" fishers of men. What does that word indicate? These men were going "to become something" (BAGD) they had never been before: fishers of men.

These men would become fishers of men. It would not happen overnight. It would take some time and training. As Robertson writes, "It would be a slow and long process, but Jesus could and would do it." You can become a fisher of men. We will help you become one. Christians should be fishers of men. Are you?
