~ Back to the Basics ~

We are currently involved in preaching a series of sermons to which we have given the title "Back to the Basics." Thus far the sermons have dealt with the problem of sin, salvation from sin, the love, grace and mercy of God, and four sermons that have discussed the inspiration and authority of the Bible.

Last Sunday's lessons dealt with the question "Is Jesus the Son of God?" There are at least five more lessons that will answer that question. They include lessons on the miracles, death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus, as well as a sermon on His role in creation. These will be followed by a sermon that asks the question, "Why Did Christ Come?" It will be based on Luke 19:10 and will emphasize the importance of evangelism. Some of these sermons will be preached on Sunday mornings, while some will be preached on Sunday evenings.

In addition to these studies about Jesus, my Sunday morning auditorium class will continue its studies in the Gospel of Luke. The Wednesday evening lessons in the auditorium class will deal with the theme of "Basic Bible Beliefs."

There are several other excellent adult Bible classes on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings. On Sundays Shad Herbert will teach the letter of Colossians and Jerry Pritchett will teach the Song of Solomon. On Wednesdays several brethren will teach a class on Financial Stewardship. Also remember the Bible Bowl Challenge on September 9. There are several wonderful Bible study opportunities for you and your family throughout this new quarter. Please take advantage of them!
