CHRIST'S CHURCH

What is Christ's church? It is His body, over which He is Head (Eph. 1:22-23; Col. 1:18). It is His because He built it (Mt. 16:18). He purchased the church with His own blood (Acts 20: 28-30). The church is His bride (Eph. 5:22-33). It is made up of the saved (Acts 2:47).

What is God's will for Christ's church? It is composed of faithful disciples (Acts 11:26). These disciples were added to the church when they obeyed the gospel (Acts 2:47). What are these faithful disciples like? For one thing, they are a unique body of people (1 Pt. 2: 1-10). For another, they are a united body of people (Jn. 17:20-21; Acts 2:42, 44; Acts 4:32; Acts 5:42; 1 Cor. 1:10; Eph. 4:4).

Again, Christ's church is made up of people who encourage each other. That is what a family is supposed to do, and the church is God's family (1 Tim. 3:15). We are not to forsake the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some. Rather, we are to exhort or encourage one another (Heb. 10:25).

The primary purpose of our assembling together is to worship, honor and glorify God. But we also assemble to encourage each other. Or, as Jude said, we are to build ourselves and each other up in the faith. One way we do this is through the encouragement we offer each other as the church, both in our assemblies and at other times. Are we encouraging each other?
