~ The Law of Love ~

Jesus taught us that we are to love God with all of our being and our neighbors as ourselves (Mt. 22: 34-40). The commandment to love our neighbors as ourselves is found in Leviticus 19: 18. The Lord also taught us that Christians are to "love one another" (Jn. 13: 34-35; 15: 12, 17). We are to love God, our neighbors and our brothers and sisters in Christ. These are commandments from our Savior (Jn. 13: 34).

The Bible is a book about relationships. This is confirmed by Romans 13: 8-10. In fact, the entire context (from Romans 12: 1 forward) can be said to be about relationships. First there is our relationship with God (12: 1-2), then our relationship with the church (12: 3-8), our relationship with other Christians (12: 9-21), our relationship with the government (13: 1-7), and our relationship with our neighbors (13: 8-14).

Each verse in Romans 13: 8-10 deals with loving others. Verse 8 serves as an explanation. It tells us who we are to love. We are to love "another" or "the other." Verse 9 is an interpretation. It describes how we are to love. Verse 10 is the conclusion. It tells us why we are to love. This is followed by the summary (13: 11-14), which closes with one of the greatest admonitions in Scripture. "But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts" (NKJB).

If we are to love God and our neighbor, it follows that we would love our brothers and sisters in the Lord. That is the point we are emphasizing today: Christians are to "love one another."
