Christian Modesty

Western movie hero "Wild Bill" Elliott used to say "I am a peaceable man." So am I. I would not intentionally upset or hurt anyone for any reason. However, when a man has been attempting to preach the gospel for over fifty-three years he has surely upset someone. I hope I do not upset anyone or hurt anyone's feelings with the sermon I am going to preach today. However, it is possible that I will.

It is that time of the year. Summer is here. It is time to say something about Christian modesty. What is modesty? Webster defines modesty as "propriety in dress, speech or conduct." (Propriety means the quality or state of being proper in conduct, speech or dress.) Webster adds that to be modest is to observe these same proprieties.

Vine writes that the Greek word translated "modest" (kosmios) means "orderly, well-arranged, decent, modest." The related word (kosmikos) "is used in 1 Tim. 2:9 of the apparel with which Christian women are to adorn themselves." Vine then cites Trench, who adds that the word is not used of the well-ordering of dress and demeanor only, but is also used to describe the inner life, uttering and expressing itself in outward conversation, conduct and dress.

This sermon is not a criticism or indictment of anyone. Nor is it a judgment. It is an effort to encourage all Christian men and women (and non-Christians also) to dress, speak and act modestly before God and man.
