*** The Exalted Christ ***

Hebrews begins with a powerful statement about Jesus. God, who "spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, has in these last days spoken to us by His Son" (Heb. 1: 1-2 NKJV). The writer lists eight important things about the Son (1: 2-4). He tells us that the Son has "become so much better than the angels" (1: 4). From 1: 5 - 2: 5 the writer emphasizes the superiority of Jesus over angels.

At 2: 6-8 the writer discusses the exaltation of the Son. At 2: 9-18 he emphasizes the humiliation of Christ. By this he tells us how completely Jesus identified with us. He became "flesh and blood" and experienced death (2: 14). In all things He was made like us. He became our "merciful and faithful High Priest" and our "propitiation" (2: 17). He suffered and was tempted (2: 18). Therefore, He is able to aid us (2: 18). Suffered, tempted, died. Now exalted (2: 7-8).

~ How We Worship ~

Today's sermon will deal with how we worship. It will be a study of John 4: 23-24. Next week, Lord willing, we will continue to discuss how we worship by examining the acts of worship commanded in the New Testament. In today's lesson we will deal with a discussion of true worshipers. In John 4: 23 Jesus said that the Father is to be the object of our worship. We discussed who we are to worship in the first lesson in this series. We worship "the living and true God" (1 Th. 1: 9).

Who is to worship Him? "True worshipers." Who is a true worshiper? One who "will worship the Father in spirit and truth." Note that "the Father is seeking such to worship Him." To seek is to ask for, request, or demand. The Father seeks true worshipers to worship the true God. As someone noted, "That God seeks men is a new and distinctly Christian idea." (See Luke 19: 10 and 15: 1-7).

John 4: 24 describes true worship. It is spiritual. Why? Because "God is Spirit." He is a spiritual Being, not material or physical (Is. 37: 19; Acts 17: 16). How are we to worship God? "In spirit and truth." Our worship is to be spiritual and in accordance with the truth (Jn. 17: 17). Notice that we MUST worship in spirit and truth.

There is the danger of false worship (Mt. 15: 9; Lev. 10: 1-2). How must we worship God? In spirit and truth.
