Christian Marriage

Oops! That looks just like the title of last week's article, doesn't it? In fact it was. However, last Sunday's article and sermon focused specifically on same-sex marriages and the Supreme Court decisions of the Wednesday before that. Today's lesson is devoted to what the Bible teaches about God's will for marriage.

We will begin with an overview of the first two chapters of Genesis and especially Genesis 2: 21-24. We will also look at another passage or two from the Old Testament. We will study Matthew 19: 1-10. While we will review what that passage teaches about divorce, the main point of the passage for our lesson today is what Jesus said about the permanency of marriage (Matthew 19: 4-6). We will also look at the relationship between a husband and wife that is a part of marriage (Eph. 5: 22-33).

Why are we doing this? It is material we have already heard taught many times. Yes, but the view of marriage is changing. Our nation and world are moving away from God's will for marriage to a view of "marriage" that is as far removed from the will of God as is the north from the south and the east from the west.

The world no longer understands God's will for marriage (if it ever did). Even more importantly, Christians must understand God's will for marriage. And our children must know and understand God's will for marriage. The home and family are under attack. So is the church. We must be ready to fight!
