CHRISTIAN LOVE

W. E. Vine calls love “the characteristic word of Christianity.” The noun and verb forms of the words appear in the New Testament many times. What does the word mean? First, God loves His Son (John 17:26). God loves those who follow His Son. In fact, “God is love” (1 John 4:8, 16). The God who loves us commands His children to love each other (1 John 4:7, 11, 12, 19-21, 2 John 5). No passage in the Bible teaches this more clearly and forcefully than John 13:34-35.

There Jesus says several very important things. He is giving us “a new commandment.” But the commandment to love has been around for a very long time (Deuteronomy 6:5; Leviticus 19:18). We are commanded to “love one another.” But what is new about this commandment is that we are to love each other “as I have loved you.” We are to follow Jesus in this and in all things.

But what does this commandment prove? “By this all people will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.” Some people are easy to love, while others may not be. But Jesus commands us to love each other. But this does not mean that we excuse or overlook their sins. We must encourage them to refrain from sin because that is the will of God and because He loves them. “Whoever loves God must also love his brother” (1 John 4:21).
