Work Out Our Salvation

We are to "work out your own salvation with fear and trembling" (Phil. 2:12). What does that mean? To "work out" is to work on to the finish, to see our commitment to Christ through to the end. We are never to quit or give up. As Churchill said, "Never, never never, never give up." Paul wrote of having "finished the race" and having "kept the faith" (2 Tim. 4: 7). The author of Hebrews admonished us to "run with endurance the race that is set before us" (12: 1). We do this by "looking unto Jesus" (Heb. 12: 2). We work out our salvation by obeying the will of God as revealed in His word (2 Tim. 3: 16-17).

While the encouragement of verse 12 is for us, the focus of verse 13 is God. "It is God who works in you." Without God we have "no hope" (Eph. 2: 12). But God works in us. "Works" is the word from which we get our work energy. God's work is His energy in action. It is His effective work as He puts forth His power to accomplish His purpose, which is our salvation (Rom. 1: 16-17; 8: 28).

Verse 13 emphasizes both God's will and work. God works in us "both to will and to do for His good pleasure." His pleasure is His purpose and satisfaction. When we obey God's will He works through us for our salvation. But we must obey His will! Because God wills (desires) our salvation and works to bring it about. But God will not force salvation on us. He allows the freedom to choose. What will you choose (Josh. 24: 15)?
