“Who Will Do All My Will”

When God was selecting a king for Israel he sent Samuel to Bethlehem. It was there that Samuel met Jesse and his sons. When Samuel saw Eliab he thought that surly he was the Lord’s anointed because Eliab was a physically impressive man. However, physical appearance was not how God determined who the king was going to be. As a matter of fact God said this to Samuel **“Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart”** (1 Samuel 16:7). We know that God eventually chose Eliab’s brother David. The reason for God choosing him is made clear by Luke. He said **“And when He had removed him, He raised up for them David as king, to whom also He gave testimony and said, ‘I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after My own heart, who will do all My will”** (Acts 13:22). What I want you to notice about these two passages is how God views His creation. The thing about David that captured the heart of God had nothing to do with his appearance. It wasn’t how handsome he was, how nicely he dressed, or how muscular he appeared that made David a man after God’s heart. The fact that he would do God’s will is why he was chosen. Let me encourage you to spend a little less time on the things we humans find important and more time of the things God values.
