The Good News

When Paul wrote to the church at Rome he informed them of something very obvious but also very sad. He said **“for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God”** (Romans 3:23). This truth is sad because Isaiah 59:1, 2 describes for us the fact that sin separates us from God. Paul would actually go on to say a few chapters later that **“the wages of sin is death”** (first part of 6:23). Obviously, this can be a depressing fact. Because all have sinned then all people deserve spiritual death.

However, Paul also gave some good news. Just because death is what we deserve does not mean death is what we will receive. He finished 6:23 by saying **“but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord”**. We all deserve death but God has made salvation possible. Paul also made it clear that this “salvation” is possible through the gospel (Romans 1:16, 17). This helps us understand why the gospel is defined as “the good news”.
