A LIVING HOPE

Christians have a living hope. How did this hope come about? “Through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead” (1 Peter 1:3). Late on that Friday afternoon the disciples removed the lifeless body of Jesus from the cross, prepared it for burial as best they could, and laid it in the tomb that belonged to Joseph of Arimathea. Then the heartbroken disciples walked away from the tomb. On that Friday all hope was buried with the lifeless body of Jesus.

Later, however, when Peter and John had seen the empty tomb and Mary Magdalene had seen the resurrected Jesus, things were very different. The same disciples who had walked away from the tomb on Friday with broken hearts walked away on Sunday with “a living hope” (1 Peter 1:3). What made the difference? Their hope had been resurrected with the resurrected Jesus.

When Paul wrote 1 Corinthians 15 he said that at the very heart of the gospel were the death, burial and resurrection of Christ (1 Corinthians 15:1-4). He also wrote that Jesus was “declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead” (Romans 1:4). When the gospel was preached in Acts, at the heart of it was the resurrection of the Lord. (See Acts 1:3, 22; 2:22-24, 30-31, 36, etc.) We have a living hope. It is based on the bodily resurrection of Jesus from the dead.
