A CHRISTIAN

A Christian is a disciple or follower of Christ, a Christ-like one. One becomes a Christian by hearing, believing and obeying the gospel of Christ (Mark 16:15-16). When one obeys the gospel he or she is added to the Lord's church (Acts 2:47). A Christian is a new person (Eph. 4:22-24; 2 Cor. 5:17; Col. 3:1-11).

Today concludes the series on the new man or woman. It looks at some of the practical results of becoming a Christian. For example, being a new person in Christ has a major impact on our worship (Col. 3:16) and on the way we live (Col. 3:17). It impacts our home and family lives (Col. 3:18-21) and our work relationships (Col. 3:22-4:1). Being a Christian has an impact on our personal lifestyle. It has an impact on our prayer lives and our thanksgiving (Col. 4:2-4), and on our speech (Col. 4:6) and conduct (Col. 4:5).

A Christian is a person who no longer belongs to himself; he or she belongs to Jesus Christ. "You were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's" (1 Cor. 6:20). That means that we live for Christ. "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me" (Gal. 2:20)
