~ God's Gifts ~

James wrote, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change" (Js. 1: 17 ESV). The paragraph in which this verse appears begins with, "Do not be deceived, my beloved brothers" (Js. 1: 16). James is writing to Christians. They are "beloved." They are told to not be deceived, which means to be led astray from the truth (Jn. 17: 17). The verse is in the imperative. It reminds us of "Be not deceived" (Gal. 6: 7-8; see 2 Cor. 4: 4).

Why are we not to be deceived? Because every good gift comes from God (Js. 1: 17). In fact James actually says that both the gift and the act of giving are good because they come from God. God does not give us bad gifts, nor is His act of giving bad. Remember that this admonition follows James 1: 13-15, where James discusses temptation. If James 1: 17 is true, and it is, then it is equally true that no temptation comes from God. Trials may come from God (Gen. 22: 1-14), but not temptations. The NASB has "Every good thing given and every perfect gift is from above." They come from God.

Who is God? "The Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shifting shadow" (NASB). God created the sun, moon and stars (Gen. 1: 1-5). The heavenly bodies may vary and change, but God does not. "O thou who changest not, abide with me."
