~ The Will of God ~

James wrote, “Of His own will He brought us forth by the word of truth” (Js. 1: 18). James called God’s word “the word of truth” (1: 18), “the implanted word” (1: 21), and “the perfect law of liberty” (1: 25). He added that we are to be “doers of the word, and not hearers only” (1: 22).

It is imperative that we obey the will of God for two reasons. First, because Jesus obeyed the will of God (Heb. 10: 5-18). He came to do God’s will (Heb. 10: 7, 9). He died on the cross in obedience to God’s will (Heb. 10: 10). Having obeyed God’s will, He “sat down at the right hand of God” (Heb. 10: 12; Ps. 110: 1). By obedience to God’s will He instituted the new covenant (Heb. 10: 16-18; Jer. 31: 31-34).

Second, we must obey the will of God because we are commanded to do so. In His Sermon on the Mount Jesus stressed the need to obey the will of God (Mt. 6: 10). In the Garden of Gethsemane He showed the necessity of obedience to the will of God (Mt. 26: 39, 42, 44).

The inspired writers emphasized the importance of obedience to God’s will. Our salvation is possible by the will of God (Gal. 1: 4). We are to do “the will of God from the heart” (Eph. 6: 6). We are to live “for the will of God” (1 Pt. 4: 2). “He who does the will of God abides forever” (1 Jn. 2: 17). Who will enter the kingdom of heaven? “He who does the will of My Father in heaven” (Mt. 7: 21).
