THE TONGUE

The tongue "is a restless evil, full of deadly poison" (James 3:8). "And the tongue is a fire, a world of unrighteousness" (James 3:6). James makes a powerful God-inspired statement about the problem of the use and misuse of the tongue (James 3:1-12).

The tongue is a fire (James 3:5-6). It cannot be tamed (James 3:7-8). With the tongue we bless and curse men (James 3:9-12). It is impossible to live a faithful Christian life unless and until we learn to control the tongue.

The tongue can be a weapon some people use to hurt others. Peter quotes Psalm 34: 12-16 in 1 Peter 3:10-12. The passage begins, "Whoever desires to love life and see good days, let him keep his tongue from evil and his lips from speaking deceit" (1 Peter 3:10).

Christians are to put away lying and speak only the truth (Ephesians 4:25). No corrupt communication is to come from our mouth (Ephesians 4:29). We must refrain from evil speaking (Ephesians 4:31). There is to be no filthiness, foolish talking, or jesting (Ephesians 5:4). We are "to speak evil of no man" (Titus 3:2). We are to lay aside "all evil speaking" (1Peter 2:1).

There is no more important and precious relationship in our lives than our relationship with God through Jesus Christ. Because we have that relationship as Christians, we also have a relationship with each other through our Lord (1 John 1:3, 7). Let us keep those relationships as proper as they should be by loving God and each other (Matthew 22;34-40; John 13:34-35).
