~ How We Worship (2) ~

In earlier sermons on worship we discussed who, why, when and how we worship. Today we continue the discussion on how we worship by discussing the acts of worship commanded by God in the New Testament. What are they?

We are to pray. Jesus prayed, sometimes all night (Mk. 1: 35; Lk. 6: 12). He taught us to pray (Mt. 6: 9-15; Lk. 18: 1). The early church "continued steadfastly in prayer" (Acts 2: 42). We are to "pray without ceasing" (1 Th. 5: 17). We are to give (1 Cor. 16: 2). We are to "Preach the word" (2 Tim. 4: 2; 2 Tim. 2: 15).

We are to observe the Lord's Supper. Jesus instituted it (Mt. 26; 26-29). The early church "continued steadfastly" in it (Acts 2: 42). They observed it on "the first day of the week" (Acts 20: 7). They observed it regularly and properly (1 Cor. 11: 17-34).

We are to sing (1 Cor. 14: 15). Two very important verses in the New Testament discuss singing (Ephesians 5: 19 and Colossians 3: 16). Both command us to "sing." The first specifies the only instrument to be used to accompany our singing: "Your heart."

Nadab and Abihu "offered unauthorized fire before the Lord, contrary to His command" (Lev. 10: 1-2). And look at the result! "So fire came out from the presence of the Lord and consumed them, and they died before the Lord." We must not add to or take from God's word. We must do what God commands.
