* A HOLY PEOPLE *

Peter calls Christians "a holy priesthood" (1 Peter 2:5) and "a holy nation" (1 Peter 2:9). Christians are to be a holy people. Peter clearly teaches this truth in his first letter. After his salutation (1 Peter 1: 1-2), the apostle reminds us that God saved us through Christ (1:35). Then he encourages us to rejoice, even in trials (1: 6-9). After reminding us of the salvation of which the prophets prophesied (1: 10-12), he tells us how we are to act as Christians (1: 13-17). Finally, he reminds us of what we know (1: 18-19).

The focus of our attention is verses 15-16. Three great facts stand out. One, God is holy. We saw this in detail in the sermon last Sunday morning on the holiness of God. Peter writes, "he which hath called you is holy" (v. 15 KJV). Verse 16 adds, "Because it is written, be ye holy, for I am holy" (Leviticus 11: 44-45).

Two, because God who is holy called us, we, as His "obedient children" (v. 14), are to "be ye holy in all manners of conversation", which means that our lives are to be holy.

Three, this is according to God's will, for "it is written" (v. 16). It is written and stands as written. The word and will of God do not change in this matter. We as God's children are to be holy because our Father in heaven is holy.

How does this work out in the living of our daily lives as Christians? That is the question we will attempt to answer in today's sermon.
