## THE BLOOD OF CHRIST

The Bible has a lot to say about the blood of Christ. We will examine some of what the New Testament says about the blood of our Lord. When Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper He said, "This is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins" (Matthew 26:28).

Jesus purchased the church with His own blood (Acts 20:28). We are "justified by His blood" (Romans 5:9). "We have redemption through His blood" (Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14). Jesus made peace between God and man "through the blood of His cross" (Colossians 1:20). He obtained redemption for us "with His own blood" (Hebrews 9:12). He sanctified us "with His own blood" (Hebrews 13:12). We are redeemed "with the precious blood of Christ" (1 Peter 1:19). If we walk in the light "the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin" (1 John 1:7).

John tells us that Jesus "loved us and washed us from our sins in His blood" (Revelation 1:5). John writes of those who have "washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb" (Revelation 7:14). He writes of those who overcame Satan "by the blood of the Lamb" (Revelation 12:11).

The Bible teaches that we are saved by the blood which Christ shed on the cross for our sins. The blood of Christ is that important. It is central to God's plan for our redemption and salvation.
