Romans 1:16 "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile." We need to be an ambassador for those who are in the Church by encouraging each other, but we also need to be an ambassador of the Church to those people who are not a member of the Church to help them develop a relationship with Christ and be reconciled to God. We have to step out of our comfort zone and not be afraid to talk about our faith, share our beliefs, and inspire others to do the same.
