A Worthless Person

“A worthless person, a wicked man, Walks with a perverse mouth; He winks with his eyes, He shuffles his feet, He points with his fingers; Perversity is in his heart, He devises evil continually, He sows discord” (Proverbs 6:12-14). Those words might seem kind of harsh, especially because the behaviors that are mentioned are not real uncommon in our world. I would like to point your attention to two of them. This passage says that those who walk with a perverse mouth are wicked. They are described as worthless. This certainly doesn't mean that the souls of these people have no value but that they cause more harm than good. They add no value to our world speaking the way they do. Solomon also said this wicked and worthless person sows discord. Let us ask ourselves “do I ever speak in a way or do anything that would cause others to be at odds”. Am I about bringing peace or discord? Let us consider our language and actions towards others then ask “could I be described as wicked or worthless?”
