SUNDAY

God raised Jesus from the dead on the first day of the week (Mt. 28:1; Mk. 16:2; Lk. 24:1; Jn. 20:1). The early church met on the first day of the week to observe the Lord's Supper (Acts 20:7) and to "lay something aside" (1 Cor. 16:2). It was on that day that Paul preached the word to the brethren at Troas (Acts 20:7). The NT church met on the first day of the week to worship. So both the first day of the week and worship on that day are very important.

Is worship on the first day of the week still important? Is it important to you? It should be! Why? First, because it is the day on which the church assembles to worship God and worship of God is important. That is not to say that midweek Bible study and other gatherings such as VBS and gospel meeting are not important. They are! But there is something very special about worship on the first day of the week.

In fact, we are commanded to assemble for worship on that day (Heb. 10:25). And Sunday evening worship is also that important because it is likewise an opportunity to worship God.

Second, assembling for worship is important because it is an opportunity to be together with those of "like precious faith" (2 Pt. 1:1) to support and encourage each other in the Christian faith. Please be here with us to worship God.

Lessons from Leviticus

Reading through the book of Leviticus can be a very daunting task. But, the book itself is full of tidbits that give us a better understanding of the New Testament teaching.

Chapter 6 begins with a discussion of lying to your neighbor and how the Israelites were to obtain atonement for this sin. Acts 5 shows the sin of lying not only belongs to the one who actually tells the lie but the ones who know about the lie also. (Acts 5:9)

We all struggle with the temptation of lying. Acts 5 clearly states that lying is from Satan and will have a negative impact on our spiritual lives. There are a number of reasons why we lie but a few are: To get recognition we do not deserve, to meet the expectations of those around us or simply to obtain something that does not belong to us.

Leviticus 6 is very clear on what had to be done by the Israelites to obtain atonement for lying to your neighbor. First, restore what he has taken and add one-fifth to the value, bring a trespass offering to the Lord and let the priest offer it as a burnt offering for his atonement.

The animal sacrifice is no longer necessary since Jesus, our high priest offered his body as a sacrifice for our sins. Jesus does teach throughout the Sermon on the Mount (Matt 5-7) that our hearts or thoughts is where sin starts. Our challenge as members of the Lord's church is to keep our minds pure and Christ centered.
