***Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain. I Corinthians 15:58***

I was in the ninth grade, and a lady in the congregation we attended was diagnosed with an aggressive form of cancer. Within months of the diagnosis, she was wheelchair bound and unable to work in her yard. That was the day my dad committed my brothers and myself to mow her grass, weed her flower beds and do anything outside she needed. What my dad was doing was showing us no matter how busy we were, we always had time to help someone in need.

During His ministry Jesus would come across multitudes of people. Some of the people were sick, some lame, and some were family members of people who had passed away. In every instance, Jesus had compassion for the people. He did what he could to meet the needs of the people he came in contact. He did not let it stop with meeting the physical needs, but did what he could to meet the spiritual needs of these people as well.

Philippians 2:5 says, "Let this mind be in you which was in Christ Jesus". The mindset of Christ was to reach as many people as he could with the Gospel. Our mindset should be the same, reach as many people as we possibly can with the Gospel. Jesus would run into the same resistance we do. I think back to the rich young ruler who walked away sadly upon hearing what he needed to do (Matthew 19:16-22). There were also the multitude of people who wanted to throw Christ off the mountain as he was beginning his ministry (Luke 2:28-30), being humiliated by the crowds as he was on trial and being lead through the streets to the site of the crucifixion. Having the mind of Christ is looking for every opportunity to talk about the Gospel with those with whom we come in contact. We will come across those, just as Jesus did, who have no desire to live a life consistent with the Gospel.
