One of the hardest parts of life is knowing that it does not last forever. The Hebrew writer made it very clear that all men will die and then face judgment (Hebrews 9:27). My prayer for us all, is not that death will never bring us sorrow, for sorrow is a natural emotion that we experience when we lose someone we love (John 11:35, 36). My prayer is that we can all, like Paul, say "For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain" (Philippians 1:21).
