THE SINLESS CHRIST (3)

Jesus is eminently qualified to be the Son of God, Savior of the world and our Lord and Master. Why? Because (1) of His eternal nature (Jn. 1: 1-18), which includes His active role in creation (Col. 1: 15-17), and (2) because of His virgin birth (Is. 7:14, Mt. 1: 23, Lk. 1: 27, 34). Two Sundays ago we introduced a third reason why Jesus is qualified to be Savior, Master and Lord. That is because of His sinless nature.

Today we will continue to study the theme of the sinless nature of Christ as we look at Matthew 4: 1-11 and Hebrews 4: 15. In Matthew 4 we will see how Jesus was tempted by the devil and how our Lord responded to those temptations. In Hebrews 4: 15 we will see that Jesus was "without sin".

For the three above reasons—with more to follow—we see that Jesus is completely and totally qualified to be "The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (Jn. 1: 29). He is the sacrificial lamb "without blemish" (Ex. 12: 5). (The NKJV footnote has "perfect or sound."). Jesus was the only perfect sacrificial lamb to be offered on the cross for the sins of the world (Eph. 1: 7, Col. 1: 14). There was and is no other.

That is why Jesus can proclaim Himself as "the way, the truth, and the life." That is why He can say, "No one comes to the Father except through Me" (Jn. 14: 6). That is the truth revealed by God.
