## The Love of God

The Bible teaches that God loves us so much that He gave His Son to die for our sins and to be raised for our justification (John 3:16-17; Romans 4:25 ESV). Or, as John later put it, "In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins (I John 4:10).

Then John wrote, "And we have known and believed the love that God has for us "to which he added, "God is love" (I John 4:16; see I John 4:8). Finally, John stated, "We love Him because He first loved us" (I John 4:19).

What did God's Son do? He took away our sins by His death on the cross (Matthew 26:28). His blood was shed for our redemption (Ephesians 1:7; Col. 1:14). "He himself bore our sins in His body on the tree," and by His stripes we are healed (I Peter 2:24).

Before we obeyed the gospel we were "ungodly" (Romans 5:9), "sinners" (Romans 5:8), and "enemies" of God (Romans 5:10). Now we are "saved by Him" (Romans 5:9). "reconciled to God" (Romans 5:9) and "justified by His blood" (Romans 5:9). (See Ephesians 2:1-10.)

Or, to put it in another way, before Christ we were lost in sin (Matthew 1:21; Romans 3:23). But Christ, who came to save us from sin, is "the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6). When we obey the gospel we are in Christ (Romans 6:1-4; Galatians 3:26-27), and are "added" to His church" (Acts 2:47). All of this happens because of the love of God for us. - Dan Cottrell
