“And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.” Colossians 3:17

(II Timothy 3:16-17) Like my father, we need to stay steadfast – we need to be involved in these efforts not only to impact others but to feed ourselves spiritually.

This summer, we have several opportunities to be involved in outreach opportunities. I want to challenge each of us to take advantage of these opportunities to reach out to our community but, also take these opportunities to build our congregation into a stronger, tighter knit family of God. Today, take a moment to honor your own fathers, and remember to honor your heavenly father daily with steadfastness.
