## PEACE

The word peace—as it appears in the Bible—often refers to “the harmonized relationships between God and man, accomplished through the gospel.” The word can, however, also refer to harmonious relationships between men, nations, and churches. This article will deal with three points: (1) peace comes from God, (2) it comes through Jesus Christ, and (3) it comes by obedience to the will of God.

Peace comes from God. Paul writes of “the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding” (Philippians 4:7). This peace comes from “the God of peace” (Philippians 4:9). The source or origin of true peace is “the living and true God” (1 Thessalonians 1:9).

Peace comes from God through Jesus Christ. Jesus said, “Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful” (John 14:27). Later Jesus added, “These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world” (John 16:33).

Peace comes from God through Jesus Christ when we obey His will. Jesus said, “If you love Me, you will keep My commandments” (John 14:15). As Jesus had already said, “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven.” Who will then? “He who does the will of My Father who is in heaven” (Matthew 7:21).
